Dear Visiting Managers & Parents,

We look forward to welcoming you at Chase Side Youth (CSY) for our upcoming fixture.

For the safety of everyone involved, please carefully read our COVID-19 Guidance below & raise any queries before travelling. **As a condition of attending our match, we require all managers, coaches, players, parents & spectators to be aware of the following guidance.**

Before the Game

1. Chase Side Youth Manager will confirm date, time, location & parking details

Arriving at the Venue

1. Follow any One-Way & COVID-19 signs in place at the Venue (including toilets)
2. Players & Managers to sanitise hands on arrival
3. Our Chase Side Youth Manager will introduce themselves to your Manager & ask them to confirm that **no visiting Player, Manager or Spectator is showing any COVID-19 Symptoms as defined by current Government Advice or living with anyone with a possible COVID-19 infection.**
4. **CSY require the AWAY team Manager to be responsible for collating a list of all visiting team managers, coaches, players & spectators & keep for 21 days to support NHS Track & Trace if required. CSY will direct NHS Track & Trace to the AWAY team Manager in the event of an infection that needs to be investigated.**
5. Spectators to socially distance along the touchline, behind the RESPECT Barrier in groups no more than 6 & max two-households.

During & After the Game

1. Please ensure players/spectators do not touch any equipment
2. CSY will sanitise the ball & goal posts before & after the game, plus at half-time
3. No shaking of hands / group huddles / group celebrations / spitting
4. Everyone to wash hands ASAP after the game
5. Continue to follow Government COVID-19 social distancing measures when leaving the venue

Risk/Hazard	Level of Risk after Controls (RED / AMBER / GREEN)	Current Precaution / Measures	Potential Further Action
COVID-19 Symptoms	Green	Managers & Parents to confirm no participant or spectator is displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 (as defined by current Government advice) & not living with a person with a possible infection. Participants & Spectators to follow updated Government advice on Covid-19 Symptoms & quarantine.	Monitor for onset of Covid-19 symptoms by participants during the matches. Stop & cease matches should symptoms be recognised. Follow Government & FA advice.
.Contact Tracing	Green	PBU Match Covid Official takes a register of all PBU attendees. PBU require the AWAY team Manager to be responsible for recording a list of all AWAY attendee contact details. This information to be kept for 21 days to support NHS Track & Trace.	
Facilities	.Green	No indoor changing rooms available, players to arrive changed & ready to play. Players & spectators to follow facility signs & guidance on social distancing within the venue buildings (including toilets & cafe)	

Start / End times	Green	All participants to be flexible around staggered start times where necessary to help ensure sufficient social distancing can be maintained specifically around car-parks arrival/departure. CSY Fixtures Secretary & Managers to discuss need for staggered KO times.	
Contactless Payments	.Green	Subs & payment for referees to be made by mobile bank transfer rather than cash.	..
.Player ID Cards	.Green	Team managers to view player ID cards using protective gloves & sanitising hands afterwards	..
Warm Up Area.	.Green	All locations provide ample space for warming up in small groups,
.Pitch Space ..	Green	Respecting FA & Govt social distance measures. Ample space for managers, coaches & subs to remain 2m apart during the game.	
Parent/Carer Facilities	Green	Spectators have been reminded to keep strict social distancing, spreading out along the touchline behind the RESPECT barrier. Groups of no more than 6 & with maximum 2 households. Spectators are reminded not to shout which could increase the spread of germs.	Managers & Covid Match Official to monitor spectators behaviour & tell them to leave the ground if necessary
.. Participant Limit	. Green	All squads including managers & coaches are well within current FA Covid-19 guidelines of 30 person groups
Before/ During/After Match	Green	No handshakes / group huddles / group goal celebrations / spitting. Managers & players to have their own named water bottle & sanitise their hands before, after & at halftime in line with FA Guidance. Goal Keepers to only use their own gloves. No swapping of shirts.	Manager & Covid Match Official working with the referee to keep reminding players of rules & stop them playing if necessary
.. Equipment Handling	. Green	Players/Spectators to avoid touching the equipment with their hands. Covid Match Official to sanitise Ball & Goal Posts before, after & at half- time	Game can be stopped by the referee & equipment re-sanitised if required
.. Non urgent first aid	. Green	Parents / Carers are to administer non urgent first aid to their child
Urgent first aid	Green	Managers and coaches have checked that they have mask, gloves and apron available in their first aid kit. PPE are to be double bagged after use and stored for 72hrs before disposal. CSY Managers to ensure they know the location of the A&E department	
.. Leaving Premises	. Green	Players & Spectators reminded to wash their hands as soon as possible after the game. When leaving the venue everyone to continue following Government advice	C.OVID Match Official can ask one team & spectators to leave the venue first if required to help maintain

		on COVID-19 safety measures. Ample space is provided at all grounds to leave the facility whilst maintaining 2m social distancing.	social distancing. ..
Football Equipment	Green	Managers are required to sanitise the equipment they use between training sessions.

Risk Rating
